Routine prevention

Use entrance mats and vacuum regularly. Busy stairs, halls, corridors, and circulation zones may need vacuuming two or three times weekly; lighter-use areas should be vacuumed at least weekly.

Respond to spills promptly

Blot liquids with clean white absorbent paper, working from the outside edge toward the centre. Scrape solids gently with a smooth object, then vacuum powders. Avoid aggressive rubbing, which can spread stains and damage fibres.

Deep cleaning

A typical professional sequence is vacuuming, local treatment, scrubbing with an appropriate cleaner, water extraction, rinsing where specified, deodorising, and rapid drying. Brush or rake the pile after cleaning and avoid prolonged direct sunlight.

Cleaning choices

Wet cleaning can suit synthetic fibres when the equipment, dilution, and drying process are correct. Dry cleaning may be selected for high-grade wool, silk, and other sensitive carpets. Do not use strong or untested chemicals continuously, as they may affect fibres and backing.

Safety

Use only products approved for the carpet. Silk and wool should not be treated with ammonia or alkaline solutions without professional guidance. Keep flammable solvents away from ignition sources and use professional help for difficult stains or chemical contamination.

Installation reminder

Before paving, ensure the substrate is clean, level, dry, and repaired; inspect materials; mark the layout; follow the arrows on tile backs; and check alignment throughout the installation.
